



Discussion and possible action: Yield sign installation.

After the recent approval and installation of Yield signs at various locations on 6th and 7th streets. Staff reviewed the intersections of Jackson & 6th and Jackson & 7th, where Stop signs are currently installed, to determine if Stop signs were still necessary. After review of the two intersections staff would recommend keeping the existing stop signs at the intersection of 6th & Jackson due to the limited visibility. Staff is requesting the council to consider approving replacement of the Stop signs at 7th & Jackson with Yield signs to allow for a better flow of traffic in this area.

Staff has prepared Ordinance #2017-17 which would allow for the placement of Yield signs at the intersection of 7th & Jackson, if the Council so chooses.

Staff is asking the Council to consider approval Ordinance # 2017-07 which would allow yield signs to be placed at the intersection of 7th & Jackson streets.



ORDINANCE NO. 2017-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 78-236 AND 78-261 OF CHAPTER 78, ARTICLE IV, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF MOSINEE PERTAINING TO DESIGNATING THE LOCATIONS OF STOP SIGNS AND YIELD SIGNS AT SELECTED STREET INTERSECTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 78-236 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Mosinee designates the street intersection locations within the City for the installation of stop traffic control signs; and

WHEREAS, Section 78-261 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Mosinee describes the street intersection locations within the City for the installation of yield of right-of-way traffic control signs; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police, the Director of Public Works and the City Administrator have identified that for traffic circulation reasons, it is necessary to remove the existing stop signs located on Jackson Street at the intersection of 7th Street and install yield traffic signs in their place; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that the removal of the existing stop signs located on Jackson Street at the intersection of 7th Street and the installation of yield traffic signs at the intersection will enhance and promote the general welfare of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Mosinee does hereby ordain as follows:

1. That Section 78-236(b) of Chapter 78 – Traffic and Vehicles, Article IV - Traffic Schedules, Division 4 – Stops, of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Mosinee is amended by deleting subsection (104) in its entirety.
2. That Section 78-261(a) of Chapter 78 – Traffic and Vehicles, Article IV - Traffic Schedules, Division 5 - Yield, of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Mosinee entitled “Yield to traffic; signs” is amended by adding the following new subsection (12) to read as follows:

- (11) On Jackson Street at its intersection with 7th Street for westbound and eastbound vehicles.
2. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to remove the existing Stop Signs and install Yield Signs at the above designated intersection.
 3. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
